

Dear Parents,

The Ladue School District is working with First Student to ensure safe bus transportation to and from school for all students. With this in mind, beginning in the fall of the 2009-2010 school year, parents of Kindergarten and First grade students will be required to complete an authorization form indicating the individuals who are authorized to meet their child at the bus stop for drop-off.

Kindergarten and First grade students will be required to have a designated individual listed on the authorization form present at the bus stop in order to get off the bus. If no one is present, the bus driver will contact the home school or Ms. Barb Myers, our Director of Transportation, to inform the parents that there was no authorized person at the bus stop. The decision will then be made to return the student to school or to make a second attempt at the bus stop.

After June 1st, parents may access the authorization form on the district website or contact Ms. Barb Myers to obtain a copy of the form. All forms must be in the school office prior to the first day of school. If you have questions or concerns regarding this new procedure, please contact Ms. Barb Myers at 994-7080.
